ROAD WORK AHEAD

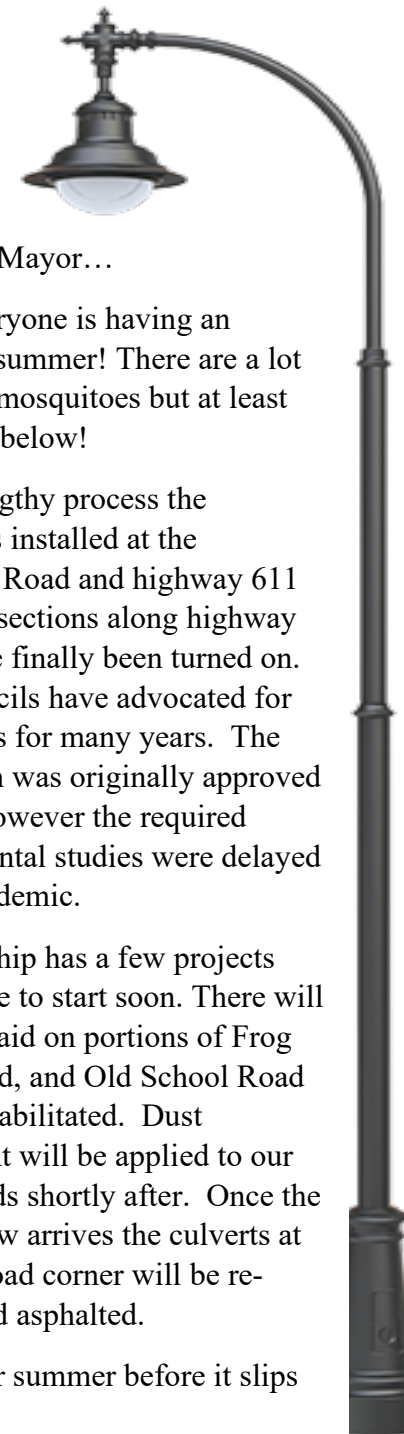

After a lengthy process the streetlights installed at the Ducharme Road and highway 611 north intersections along highway 11/71 have finally been turned on. Prior councils have advocated for these lights for many years. The installation was originally approved in 2019, however the required environmental studies were delayed by the pandemic.

The township has a few projects that are due to start soon. There will be gravel laid on portions of Frog Creek Road, and Old School Road will be rehabilitated. Dust suppressant will be applied to our gravel roads shortly after. Once the paving crew arrives the culverts at the Hill Road corner will be re-bedded and asphalted.
