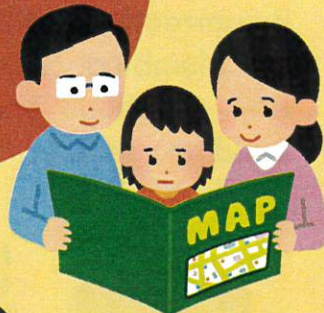

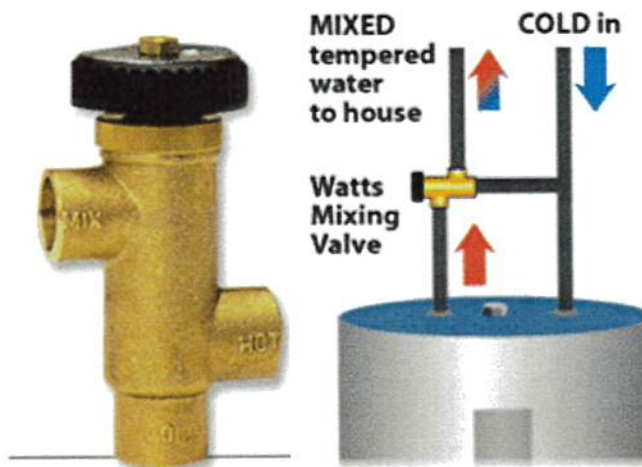

To prevent bacteria from forming in your water heater, the water temperature should be kept at 60 degrees Celsius (140 F), however, to prevent scalding, the water temperature at sinks, tubs and showers should be reduced to 49 degrees Celsius (120 F). This can be achieved by correctly installing a mixing valve on the plumbing. See diagram below. For any questions you may have about building safety, talk to your local building official.
