

## FRIENDLY REMINDER

Allowing your dog to run at large off of your property is not permitted. No matter how friendly and well-behaved your dog is, as per the Dog Owners Liability Act, as a dog owner, it is your responsibility to be in control of your dog at all times. Please be a responsible pet owner.



## HOLIDAY LIGHTING SAFETY TIPS

- Use outdoor-rated LED lights and hang with nail-free clips to prevent wire damage.
- Check every strand for frayed wires, broken bulbs, or loose connections before use. Discard damaged sets immediately.
- Consider switching to all LED lights to avoid overheating and reduce energy use.
- Only use certified lights and timers (look for CSA, ULC, or ETL marks).
- Never leave lights on overnight or when you're away from home, to avoid overheating.

## Winter Safety Tip

Ensure your driveway has a clear line of sight in both directions by pushing snow back as far as possible from the roadway. Small vehicles sometimes need to creep into the main roadway to look for oncoming traffic and can pose a hazard.
