Before igniting a fire of any kind, activate your burn event by calling (807) 907-2282. Always ensure you have adequate water and tools on hand to manage the fire safely. **REMEMBER:** Daytime burning is not permitted in Alberton between March 1st - October 31st. An open air fire may be ignited no earlier than 3 hours before sunset and must be extinguished no later than 3 hours after sunrise.
