TIPS FOR SHARING THE ROAD WITH SLOW-MOVING VEHICLES (SMV)

Haying is well underway which means sharing the road with slow-moving tractors and farm equipment. Here are a few tips for sharing the road with slow-moving vehicles.

- Reduce your speed as soon as you see the slow moving sign (red and orange triangle) and stay back at least 50 feet.
- Make sure there is enough room to pass safely without braking immediately in front of the SMV.
- Large vehicles require more room to complete a turn, so don't assume they are letting you pass if they move onto the shoulder.
- Pay attention for hand signals or signal lights and do not pass until it is safe to do so.
- When approaching horses or livestock on the road, pass slowly and cautiously to avoid "spooking" the animal.
- Be patient and share the road. SMV's will be out of the way as soon as possible.
